Primary Function: To support the academic program within the classroom, including meeting with small groups and testing. May teach math classes.	

Requirements

1. Educational Level: Bachelor's Degree

Essential Duties

1. Support the academic growth needs of students, both high and low students
2. To Dibels test students, as needed, and monitor progress at scheduled intervals
3. Teach math class within a grade, if needed (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades remedial)
4. Facilitate flooding and small reading groups
5. Proctor tests as needed and assess new incoming students
6. Assist with Kindergarten Orientation
7. Plan and participate K & 1 Literacy events
8. Teach writing groups, as needed
9 As needed, participate in Parent-Teacher conferences
10. Other duties as assigned: Cover for classroom teacher, carpool, etc.
