When is tuition due?

Tuition will post at the time you accept your schedule. Your tuition will be billed every Friday for the following week.

When is the last day to select an Event or Class?

You have through Wednesday to select a schedule for the following week.

How do I change or cancel my schedule?

All schedule cancellations or adjustments need to be submitted to vortega@ckcs.net by the end of day Wednesday.

Where do I pick up/drop off my child for Core Care Club?

Please have your child come in through the door on the east side of the main building, located just to the left of the preschool entrance, if you use Core Care Club in the morning. In the afternoon, you will also pick up your child at this door

Will I be allowed to enter the building to sign out my child?

Parents will not be allowed into the building until further notice. We will bring your child to you and have two staff members sign them out on your behalf.



What sort of paperwork do I need to provide?

There is no paperwork that needs to be submitted to the Core Care Club. All information needed is captured online.

What if my child has an allergy or health care plan?

We will have access to the school's health room, medications and health plans. Additionally, the Director of the program will be in regular contact with the school nurse. You may be contacted if more information is needed.

What do I need to send with my child(ren) to Core Care Club?

Please send your child with a book or two to read. We will not have a community library. Also, we encourage families to send their children with their own writing/coloring utensils.

Will snacks be provided at Core Care Club?

Yes, children will be offered individually packaged snacks every day.

Will my child have to wear a mask?

Per Governor Polis' mask order, anyone 11 years of age or older is required to wear a mask while in the program.

What are some of the safety protocols you will be putting in place?

- Children will be required to wash their hands anytime they are entering/leaving the main program area.
- Thorough and consistent cleaning and disinfecting will occur daily on all items the children will be in contact with.
- We will observe social distancing within the program and during transitions.
