

PCK Sent Home Due to Illness Form 20-21

Your student is being sent home today from school due to illness symptoms checked below.

- Skin eruptions / rashes
- Nausea / vomiting / diarrhea
- Severe abdominal pain
- Fever of 100° or higher
- Decreased activity - droopy, tired appearance
- Irritable behavior
- Sore throat / swollen glands
- Runny nose / cough
- Eye drainage (excessive drainage and significant discomfort)
- Other _____

When can my student return to school after being sent home sick?

Students sent home from school are asked to stay home *the following day also* in order to determine what symptoms are due to and also to prevent the spread of infections. After that your student may return to school if:

1. **If your student has been FREE OF all of their SYMPTOMS for at least 24 hours including being fever free 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.**

Exception: For vomiting and/or diarrhea that is accompanied by other illness symptoms students must stay home until they are free of vomiting and diarrhea for 48 hours.

2. **Your student is diagnosed by your health care provider with the following conditions your student may return after 24 hours of medication:**

- o Strep throat
- o Infected skin eruptions (rashes)
- o Other conditions requiring antibiotics

Exception: If being treated for Pertussis, student must be on antibiotics for 5 days before returning to school
